

# Navy intercepts boat with 4,000 litres of suspected stolen AGO

The Nigerian Navy Ship (NNS) BEECROFT Thursday said the successful interception of a boat carrying approximately 4,000 litres of product suspected to be Automotive Gas Oil (AGO), is a major boost in the ongoing effort to combat economic sabotage in Lagos waterways.

The interception occurred in the early hours of Saturday around the Commodore Pool within the Atlas Cove general area. The operation was executed by an NNS BEECROFT patrol team stationed at Tarkwa Bay, utilising intelligence from the Western Regional

Control Centre of the Falcon Eye Alignment, the Nigerian Navy's Maritime Domain Awareness facility.

The executive officer, NNS BEECROFT, who addressed the press on behalf of the commander, Commodore Paul Ponfa Nimmye, said the suspects abandoned the Fibre Boat and fled upon sighting the patrol team.

The successful operation is in direct line with the strategic directive of the Chief of the Naval Staff, Vice Admiral Emmanuel Ikhechukwu Ogalla, to maintain a credible presence across Lagos waterways and adjoining creeks to eliminate all forms of maritime crime.

The recovered product

has been officially handed over to the representative of the Nigeria Security and Civil Defence Corps (NSCDC) Lagos state command, Superintendent Amoo Kehinde, for necessary follow-up action and prosecution.

Captain Udoessien issued a strong warning to perpetrators of maritime crimes: "NNS BEECROFT will not rest on its oars to pursue all criminal elements operating within its area of operation."

He affirmed that the Navy will continue to intensify surveillance, patrols, and intelligence-driven missions to deny criminals the freedom to operate and ensure socio-economic activities thrive.

## Oil spill clean-up: We're up to uncover truth behind fund utilisation-Reps

The ad hoc committee of the House of Representatives investigating the management of oil spill clean-up funds in the Niger Delta Thursday said it will uncover the truth behind how funds allocated for the exercise were applied by the Hydrocarbon Pollution Remediation Project (HYPREP).

The committee also reaffirmed its commitment to ensuring transparency, accountability and justice in the handling of its investigation to ensure that affected communities receive the relief and restitution they deserve. Chairman of the committee, Hon. Okpolorun Etehe, gave the assurance at an investigative session Thursday in Abuja, saying: "We will scrutinise project implementation, procurement processes, training programmes, intelligence coordination, and the actual delivery of remediation and restitution to Niger Delta communities."

He said the probe would also assess the performance of regulatory agencies, the level of transparency in contract awards, and the

progress of remediation projects already funded by the federal government and its partners.

"When monitoring and verification reveal gaps, delays, or irregularities, the committee will not hesitate to identify those responsible and recommend corrective measures. This is about ensuring that funds meant for environmental recovery are used effectively for the people who have suffered the most," Etehe said.

He further called on government agencies and institutions involved in the oil spill clean-up process to fully cooperate with the

committee by submitting all relevant information and documents promptly.

Speaker of the House, Abbas Tajudeen, represented by the Majority Whip, Hon. Usman Bello Kumo, stated that the hearing was not meant to witch-hunt any institution or individual.

"We appeal to the agencies concerned to appear before this committee with the necessary information and evidence that will help the committee make fair, balanced and just recommendations," he said.
